Literacy:

Daily phonics -learning individual letter sounds and blending them together to make words. Starting to read some 'tricky' words.

Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.

Mathematics:
Count objects, actions and sounds.
Link the numeral with the number of objects.
Solve real world maths problems with numbers to 5.
